- In general good health
- At least 12 weeks of age
- Spayed or neutered (6 months or older)
- Uptodate on all vaccinations including: Rabies \_\_\_\_ DHLPP\_\_\_\_ Bordatella\_\_\_\_
- On a scheduled flea & tick prevention program

Proof of the above must be presented during the interview.

Finally, the Standard Agreement should be thoroughly reviewed and signed.
