RULES AND REGULATIONS

The purpose of DOG n' SUDS Doggy Daycare is to provide a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for your dogs during our business hours. To ensure the safety and health of your pet and our other guests, we require that you comply with the following:

AGE: All dogs must be at least 12 weeks of age and of a size which assures their safety within our facility.
All dogs must be spayed or neutered (Exception for puppies under a year where their ability to attend will be decided at staff discretion based on their behavior to ensure the safety of all dogs in our care).

Vaccinations: All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations, including rabies. Owners must submit written proof that their dogs have received DHLPP and Bordetella vaccinations within the last 11 months. All vaccinations must be given by a veterinarian or their authorized tech. We also accept Titer testing as an alternative. If your dog is unable to be vaccinated due to health reasons we require a note from your veterinarian confirming this.

Fleas: All dogs must be on a preventative flea and tick program such as Frontline, Advantage, Bio-Spot or Program.

Health: All dogs must be in good health. Owners will need to certify that their dog is in good health and has not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. On admission, all dogs must be free from any condition which could potentially jeopardize the health of our other guests. Dogs who have been ill with a communicable condition within the last 30 days will require a veterinarian's certification of health to be admitted or readmitted. If your dog shows any common symptoms of communicable condition while in daycare, they will be separated from the other dogs and you will be contacted and asked to come pick your pup up as soon as possible. If your dog is showing symptoms of common communicable conditions upon entry, we may refuse care until their symptoms are completely cleared.

Injuries: Your pups are always monitored and never unattended, but as dogs do play with their mouths and paws there is always the potential for injury. We do have staff trained in DogSafe Canine First-Aid so for minor injuries we will apply the appropriate care and you will be informed upon pick up. For any larger injury you will be contacted as we perform necessary first-aid.

Behavior: All dogs must be non-aggressive. Please remember that your dog will be spending time with other dogs in the occasional presence of toys and that their safety and health is our main concern. DOG n' SUDS reserves the right to immediately expel any dog for aggressive or poor behavior or violation of the rules and regulations. If your dog has shown any signs of aggression towards dogs or humans, you must inform the staff so we can work with you and your pup to ensure the safety of all in our care. Please inform the staff if your dog shows any signs of guarding towards dogs, people, toys or any other resources. We love all dogs and are very willing to work with you as long as you give us your full cooperation. For some dogs, full days in daycare can be too much or even certain times of the day may be too much for dogs that may be easily stressed and overstimulated. We may also request certain

lengths of stay or times of day to ensure we have the staff available to keep everyone safe and having fun. If the guidelines put in place by the staff members are not followed, then you may be unable to continue bringing your dog to play as we may not be the correct fit.

Handling: All dogs in our care must be accepting of physical touch and handling. Our staff are trained in the proper way to approach nervous dogs but for safety reasons they must allow touch. In the case of rough play, we often use touch to redirect and in the case of dogs showing aggressive behaviors we need to be able to restrain them and remove them from the situation. Staff all carry slip leads for this purpose. If you have a dog that is nervous or reactive regarding touch, please inform a staff member so we can help work with you and your pup.

Daycare Interview: All dogs and owners must go through an initial meet and greet to check the dog for anti-social tendencies. This must be completed prior to the first day of daycare.

Viewing and Dog Room Access: For peace and safety in the dog room, viewing area access is limited at staff discretion. Any access behind gated areas is prohibited without staff accompaniment. If you want to see what your pup does during the day we do have cameras that you can watch your puppies play! These can be accessed from our website on your computer or phone and they are available between the hours of 9-11 am and 1-3 pm. There are cameras at our big dog and small dog locations so ask a staff member for the password so you can join in on the fun!

Fees: A rate sheet is attached. Fees are due and payable on the day which daycare services are provided.

Days and Hours: Our Big Dog location is open for daycare from 7 am -7 pm Monday to Friday and 9 am – 5 pm on Saturdays. The Small Dog location is open from 7:30 am – 4 pm on Mondays and 7:30 am – 5 pm Tuesday-Fridays. When Small Dog closes for the night, the remaining dogs are brought over to our Big Dog location where they will be available to be picked up until 7 pm on weekdays or 5 pm on Saturdays. Our staff go off duty as soon as the last dog is picked up but for any pet remaining after 7:00 pm (or 5:00 pm on Saturdays), there will be a **\$2.00-per-minute late charge.**

Please ensure your dog is on a FLAT leash and collar when you drop them off. We do NOT accept Flexi leashes, prong, choke, shock or e-collars.

Reservations: Reservations are preferred 24 hours in advance. If you call on the day that daycare is needed there is no guarantee of a spot. We will do our best to accommodate.
